Christmas 1987

The 1987 Christmas sheets retained the format of the prior year, but dropped the red frame. The designs are Moose (from the 1964 Xmas booklet, Lois & Louis Darling), Black-Capped Chickadee (Charles L. Ripper), Spruce (Lois & Louis Darling), Eastern Cottontail (from 1968 Xmas sheet, Walter A. Weber)), White-Winged Crossbill (from 1968 Xmas booklet, Guy Coheleach), and Northern Bobwhite (Charles L. Ripper). The Spruce design appears in the upper left sheet margin and could be considered the 31st stamp in the sheet.



In the 1987 Christmas poster stamp sheet, all designs are portrayed as poster stamps and two (Spruce and Northern Bobwhite) are portrayed twice in this large format.
